Question	Correct	Incorrect
Previous preterm delivery was from spontaneous labor or PPROM		
Previous preterm delivery was a singleton		
Current pregnancy is singleton		
No history thrombosis or thromboembolism		
No history of breast cancer or other hormone sensitive cancers		
No history of cholestatic jaundice of pregnancy		
No history of liver tumor or active liver disease		
No history of uncontrolled hypertension		
Less than 20 6/7 weeks in current pregnancy		

If all of the above answers are correct, the patient should be considered for administration of weekly 17-OH progesterone if there are no other contraindications. Therapy should be initiated after 16 weeks of gestation.
